### **24 YEAR OLD MALE BEING SOUGHT AFTER LEAVING SCENE OF CRASH**

**(SEVERN TOWNSHIP, ON)** – At approximately midnight on Sunday July 10, 2011 the Orillia Ontario Provincial Police (OPP) responded to a multi vehicle crash.

The crash on Highway 11 north near Menoke Beach Rd. in Severn Township involved two vehicles.

A 35 year old male of Ramara Township was driving a mini van northbound on Highway 11 when he observed a pick up truck also travelling northbound approaching at a high rate of speed. The driver of the pick up truck changed lanes and struck the mini van forcing the mini van into the guard rail.

The 34 year old female passenger of the mini van also of Ramara Township, was transported to Orillia Soldiers' Memorial Hospital suffering from non-life threatening injuries.

The OPP Canine and the Emergency Response Team (ERT) were called to the scene to search for the missing driver of the pick up truck.

The driver of the pick up truck is still outstanding. A 24 year old Orillia male has been identified and a warrant is being sought for his arrest.

Highway 11 was closed for a number of hours due to the investigation of this crash and the OPP would like to thank the public for their patience in any delays they experienced.
