### BREAK AND ENTER RESULTS IN THEFT OF BOAT

**(SEVERN TOWNSHIP, ON)** – On May 11, 2011 at approximately 3:30 p.m. Orillia Ontario Provincial Police responded to a call of a break and enter.

The break and enter happened sometime between Monday May 9, 2011 and Wednesday May 11, 2011 at the reported time.

Stolen from a residence in the area of Richardsons Point Line and Maleys Road of Severn Township, was a 20 foot Four Winns Bow Rider, model 200 Horizon, green and white with a 220 hp V6 Ford engine Volvo out drive. The boat and matching trailer were taken from the garage.



Estimated value of the boat, engine and trailer is to be \$20,000.
