### **DRUG WARRANT EXECUTED IN RAMARA TOWNSHIP**

**(Ramara Township, ON.)** – On July 29<sup>th</sup> 2011, the OPP (Ontario Provincial Police) Organized Crime Enforcement Bureau – Drug Enforcement Unit along with the assistance of the Asset Forfeiture Unit, USAR (Urban Search and Rescue) CBRNE (Chemical, Biological, Radiological and Nuclear) Response Team (UCRT) and the Orillia Detachment Street Crime Unit, executed a Controlled Drugs and Substances Act (CDSA) Search warrant at a Willison Side Road residence, in the Township of Ramara.

Police located and seized 24 pounds of packaged cannabis marihuana and a large quantity of cash.

Street value of the cannabis marihuana seized is \$108,390.00

The two occupants of the residence were arrested and charged with possession of cannabis marihuana for the purpose of trafficking. One other occupant of the residence is to be located and charged.

The two arrested were released from police custody with a court date of September 6<sup>th</sup> 2011.
