INJURED YOUTH FACING CHARGES

(ORILLIA, ON.) – As a result of an investigation a male youth from Orillia has been charged with various Criminal Code offences.

On July 5, 2010, Orillia OPP arrested and charged a 17 year old male. The youth will be attending Orillia Court in September 2010.

An investigation revealed that on June 29, 2010 the male had created a small explosive device. While at a local park the device imploded and the male was injured.

No one else was injured.

The youth attended Orillia Soldiers' Memorial Hospital and was treated for injuries sustained from the implosion.

The Orillia OPP would like to remind the public of the dangers of creating explosive mixtures.

Mixing chemicals with the purpose to create an explosive device or experimenting with explosives can prove to be deadly and can result in criminal charges.
