LARGE AMOUNT OF ILLEGAL DRUGS SEIZED IN RAMARA TOWNSHIP

(RAMARA TWP, ON) – On November 10th, 2011 at approximately 4:00 a. m., the Orillia Ontario Provincial Police (OPP) detachment members executed a Controlled Drugs and Substances Act (CDSA) search warrant.

As a result of investigative work by the police, the warrant was prepared and executed at a residence in Ramara Township. The male inside the residence was arrested and has been charged with criminal offences.

Approximately 41 pounds of suspected marihuana was seized. The street value of the marihuana is estimated to be 62,870 dollars.

Ron ELSON age 48 of Ramara Township has been charged with Possession for the Purpose, Possession of cannabis and Unsafe storage of a firearm. He is scheduled to appear in court on December 20, 2011.
