OPP LAY ATTEMPT MURDER CHARGES

(ORILLIA, ON) – On Sunday May 22nd, 2011 at approximately 2:45 pm, several officers from the Orillia Ontario Provincial Police (OPP) responded to a serious occurrence in the City of Orillia.

A residence on Albert Street north was the scene of a break in and assault. Several people were in the residence at the time. A male and female forced their way into the residence and assaulted one of the occupants. An ambulance was called for one male party who had several stab wounds. Officers arrested a male and female inside the residence.

Wayne CAMPBELL age 43, of Orillia has been charged with the following offences: Attempt Murder, Utter Threat to cause Death or Bodily Harm, Possession of Weapon for Dangerous Purpose, Robbery with Intent and Unlawfully in a Dwelling House.

Michelle TENNANT age 36, of Orillia has been charged with the following offences: Attempt Murder, Robbery with Intent, Possession of Weapon for Dangerous Purpose and Unlawfully in a Dwelling House.

Both TENNANT and CAMPBELL were held for a bail hearing on May 23, 2011.

The extent of the victim's injuries is not known at this time.
