FATAL MVC IN RAMARA TOWNSHIP

(ORILLIA, ON) – On Thursday August 11, 2011 at approximately 8 p.m. Orillia Ontario Provincial Police (OPP) responded to a report of a head on collision in Ramara Township.

The collision occurred on Rama Road, approximately 1 km north of the Monck Road, just south of Rama. Two vehicles were involved.

Ramara Fire, Rama Police, Rama Fire and ambulance also attended the scene. The OPP Technical Traffic Collision Investigation Unit (TTCI) were called in to assist with the investigation as one driver was pronounced deceased at the scene.

At this point it appears the male driver of the southbound vehicle crossed over the centre line striking a northbound vehicle head on. He was air lifted to St. Michaels hospital in Toronto and is reported to have non life threatening injuries. The male driver is 27 years old and is from Cobourg Ontario.

The driver of the northbound vehicle was a 23 year old female from Sharon Ontario. She was pronounced deceased at the scene. Her female passenger who is also 23 years of age was transported to Orillia Soldiers Memorial Hospital with non life threatening injuries and has since been released from the hospital. She is from Newmarket Ontario.

Police have several witnesses and are continuing to investigate. Charges are pending. Once the investigation is complete, names of the people involved will be released.

To assist with the investigation, the road was closed for several hours but has since re-opened.
