### **PEDESTRIAN STRUCK, DRIVER CHARGED, MINOR INJURIES**

**(ORILLIA, ON)** – On July 4<sup>th</sup>, 2011 at approximately 1:30 pm, a pedestrian was struck while crossing at the intersection of Front Street and Mississauga Street in the city of Orillia.

Orillia Ontario Provincial Police (OPP) attended the scene. The 31 year old female pedestrian from Coldwater was transported by ambulance to Orillia Soldiers Memorial Hospital. She is reported to have minor injuries.

The driver of the vehicle, a 38 year old male from Mississauga Ontario, was charged with Failing to Yield to a Pedestrian.

Police would like to take this opportunity to remind motorists to look all ways before proceeding at any intersection.

The advice for pedestrians is to be aware of your surroundings and be sure to make eye contact with drivers when walking on the roadway and crossing the street.
