### RAMARA MAN IMPAIRED BY DRUG

**(ORILLIA, ON)** – On Thursday June 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2011 at approximately 7:00 pm, officers from the Orillia Ontario Provincial Police (OPP) responded to a complaint regarding a single motor vehicle collision. The incident happened on Colborne street east, in the City of Orillia.

Two hours earlier, the same vehicle, a black pickup truck had been involved in a driving complaint west of Orillia.

Witness statements indicated the driver almost hit a pedestrian before striking the decorative light standard.

The male driver was arrested at the scene for being impaired by a drug. He was taken to the Orillia OPP detachment where he was held for a bail hearing.

No one was injured however there was damage to the light standard.
