SUSPICIOUS VEHICLE CITY OF ORILLIA

(ORILLIA, ON.) – On Wednesday, the 28th of April 2010, at 1:00 p.m., a motor vehicle was stopped at the traffic light facing Southbound at the intersection of West Street North and Brant Street in the City of Orillia. There were three occupants in the vehicle.

At this time an 11 year old boy was crossing the street at that location.

The rear female passenger in the car began to call the boy in an attempt to lure him over to her area of the vehicle.

The youth ran from the scene and advised his dad.

The police attended the scene and searched the area for the suspect vehicle.

Description of the vehicle:

Mid 90's, beige, four door car with damage to front driver's side. The rear antenna had a red ball on it.

Description of occupants:

Driver: Male, bald, dark goatee, tall with dark sun glasses.

Front Passenger: Female

Rear Passenger: Female, white, early to mid 40's, acne on her face, brown hair pulled back into a pony tail.

The OPP is asking the general public to call police if they have any information on this incident or if they observe this vehicle.
