TRAFFIC STOP IN ORILLIA RESULTS IN SEIZURE OF COCAINE

(ORILLIA, ON) – On June 21st, 2011, the Ontario Provincial Police (OPP) Organized Crime Enforcement Bureau – Drug Enforcement Unit along with the assistance of the Orillia OPP Detachment Street Crime Unit, stopped a vehicle at the corner of Mary Street and O'Brien Street in Orillia after receiving information the occupants were in possession of a quantity of Crack Cocaine.

As a result of this traffic stop 22.3 grams of suspected cocaine was seized.

Greg CARRICK, age 24 of Ramara Township was charged with two counts of Breach of Probation, Drive Disqualified and Possession of Cocaine.

CARRICK was held for a bail hearing on June 22nd, 2011.

Christopher PETERSON, age 38 of Orillia was charged with Possession of Cocaine for the Purpose of Trafficking and released with a court date of August 9th 2011.
