CDSA SEARCH WARRANT EXECUTED IN SEVERN TOWNSHIP -UPDATE-

(Severn Township, ON.) – On Friday May 6, 2011 at approximately 3 p.m., the Organized Crime Enforcement Bureau – Drug Enforcement Unit members of the Orillia OPP Detachment, executed a Controlled Drugs and Substances Act (CDSA) Search warrant at a residence on Cambrian Road, in Severn Township.

Inside the residence Police located and dismantled a marihuana grow operation, seizing 1019 marihuana plants varying in size from six inches to approximately four feet in height.

Police also located and seized 43 pounds of dried marihuana bud.

Estimated street value of the drugs seized is \$1.2 Million.

Randy BEEMER, age 54 and Deborah BEEMER, age 53 both of Severn Township have been arrested and charged. Both accused have been charged with Possession of Cannabis Marihuana for the Purpose of Trafficking and Production of Cannabis Marihuana.

Both have a court appearance in Orillia on June 14, 2011.
