UPDATE - OPP RELEASE NAME SUSPECT CAUGHT WITH STOLEN BOAT AND MORE !

(SEVERN TWP, ON) – Orillia Ontario Provincial Police (OPP) received a report of a Break, Enter and Theft from a marina in Cumberland Beach, Severn Township at approximately 4:15 a.m. on July 5th, 2011.

The owner of the marina provided police with the details of a boat and trailer which had been stolen from his business.

Police observed the boat and trailer travelling southbound on Highway 11 just north of the City of Orillia. When police attempted to stop the vehicle which continued driving but when other police units got involved, the driver gave up and came to a stop. The driver who was the lone occupant of the pickup truck was arrested without incident.

As it turns out, the pickup truck and licence plates were also stolen from Kitchener. The recovered boat is a 31 foot Formula. The boat and trailer combined are valued at approximately \$200,000 dollars.

The accused is a 28 year old Ronald Kyle TOWLE of London Ontario. He was held for a bail hearing and is still in custody facing numerous charges.

Charges include: Breach of Probation, Flight from Police, Theft Over x 2, Break and Enter with Intent, Possession of Stolen Property Over \$5,000 x 3 and Possession of Stolen Property Under \$5,000.
