UPDATE - Sexual Assault OPP Remind Public to be aware of personal Safety

(ORILLIA, ON) – Orillia OPP is requesting the public's assistance in the investigation of a sexual assault which occurred this morning, the 27th of August 2011 at approximately 2:00 am in the area of the Metro Grocery store. A female victim was walking when she was attacked and sexually assaulted by an unknown male suspect.

The suspect was described as having a stocky build, wearing a light coloured ball cap, possibly jeans and running shoes with white colouring.
