Chair MacNeil called the public meeting of the Board to order at 9:30 a.m.

Business Arising From the Minutes

Inspector Goard reported that the concerns of Matthew Sturrock, 800 West Ridge Ave. were noted at the NCO meeting with the result being increased directed patrols and enforcement with radar. With respect to noise complaints, a study is being conducted of a similar situation in Barrie solved through increased bylaw fines to ascertain if it might be an effective solution in Orillia. Inspector Goard noted Mr. Sturrock has been advised of the police action.

With respect to personal motor scooters Inspector Goard reported there is no provincial law that governs them. It was noted that the City bylaw encourages them to ride on sidewalks.

Inspector Goard noted no new information has been received on the updating of the False Alarm Bylaw to include unpaid fines with property taxes. A report will be tabled at the next meeting.

It was further suggested that public awareness needs to be increased on the “no left turns” at intersections in the City by way of the City Bulletin Board.
